

Notice of ground investigation works on Red Lane





High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain which will provide a vital transport link for the country. Initial works on Phase One of HS2, from London to the West Midlands, have now started. These early works are carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

We will be in your area to carry out ground investigation works. These trial hole surveys will allow us to identify utilities located along a short section of Red Lane.

The surveys at the junction will be carried out over the weekend of the **15th and 16th December**, subject to site conditions and permits.

Red Lane will be closed from 7am on Saturday 15th December to 7pm on Sunday 16th. Access will be maintained for all households along Red Lane. An agreed and clearly signed local diversion will be in place along Hob Lane, Windmill Lane and the A452 Kenilworth Road.

Duration of works

A full closure of Red Lane over the weekend of the 15th and 16th December, followed by a second weekend in January.

The road will be closed from 7am on Saturday 15th December, to 7pm on Sunday 16th.

What to expect

Work will be carried out from 8am to 5pm on both days.

Some noise from on-site machinery during working hours.

A diversion route will be in place during the closure of Red Lane.

Access for residents, pedestrians and cyclists will be maintained.
